Dylan Edmands, Aiden Gartner and Jack Klippenstein all racked up 10 points. Also contributing for the Monarchs were Kaleb Kardash (8 points, 4 rebounds, 1 block), Kendall Keller (6 points, 3 rebounds), Manny Ramos (3 points, 2 rebounds, 1 block), Noah Sorrell (2 points, 3 rebounds), and Carson Matt (2 points, 1 rebound, 1 steal). The Jr. Boys finished the game with 45 rebounds (16 offensive / 29 defensive), six blocks and 32 steals.
