8. **Monarchs Win versus Johnson Collegiate:** Kaleb Kardash's 20 points propelled the Junior Boys to a 77-43 victory over Johnson on Monday. The Monarchs pulled ahead early, claiming a 34-25 lead at the half. Kardash was on the ball from the field, making 41% (9-for-22) of shots attempted. Three other players also added ten or more points for the Jr. Boys. Dylan Edmands added 19 points, Brody McNight racked up 16 points, and Kendall Keller contributed 12 points. Also chipping in for the Monarchs were Noah Sorrell (4 points, 1 rebound, 1 block) and Nic Rein (3 points, 4 rebounds, 2 steals). McNight was a big defensive contributor as well, racking up 15 rebounds and six steals. The Jr. Monarchs finished the game with 57 rebounds (22 offensive / 35 defensive), three blocks and 30 steals.
